NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS for quashing of FIR No.0001 dated 13.08.2022 registered under Section 498-A IPC at Women Police Station, Sangrur, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 02.11.2022 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurdev Kaur submits that initially the FIR was registered against the petitioner only but thereafter, on an application filed by the prosecution under Section 319 Cr.P.C., six additional accused have been summoned to face trial under Section 406 and 498-A IPC, however, the instant petition has been filed only on behalf of one accused i.e. the petitioner-husband and thus, in view of law laid down by the Division Bench of this Court in *Rakesh Das Vs. State of Haryana and another* passed in CRM-M-48043-2023 on 12.11.2024 (Neutral Citation 2024:PHHC:147654-DB), the instant petition seeking quashing of FIR based on partial compromise is not maintainable.



3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one, on the same cause of action, at an appropriate stage, on behalf of all accused persons.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
