1. The petitioners are challenging the order dated 08.10.2024 passed in criminal complaint No. NACT/456/2019 tilted as *Adgel Corporation vs. M/s Balaji Fiber Reinforce Pvt. Ltd.* whereby, the bail of petitioners No.2 and 3 was cancelled and their bonds were forfeited to State and the order dated 05.12.2024 whereby, proclamation has been ordered to be issued against petitioners No.2 and 3 for 20.01.2025.

2. It is *inter alia* contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners No.2 and 3 are ready to pay entire cheque amount and to abide by the other terms and conditions to be imposed upon them. They are also ready and willing to appear before the learned trial Court and to join proceedings. As such, it is urged that the impugned orders be set aside and they be permitted to appear before learned trial Court and be ordered to be released on bail.



3. A perusal of the impugned orders dated 08.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) and 05.12.2024 (Annexure P-3) reveals that previously also, proceedings under Section 82 of Cr.P.C. had been initiated against the petitioners and some compromise has also been effected but the petitioners failed to abide by the terms and conditions of the said compromise and even absented themselves due to which coercive action had been ordered to be taken against them. However, keeping in view the fact that they are ready to appear before the learned trial Court and to abide by the terms and conditions to be imposed upon them and also to pay the amount of cheque in question, the petition is disposed of with a direction to petitioners No.2 and 3 to appear before the learned trial Court on or before 20.01.2025 and to move application for grant of bail and also to abide by the terms and conditions thereof. On their surrender, learned trial Court shall take into consideration the offer of the petitioners to pay the amount of cheque in question and if the same is acceptable by the complainant, the said amount may be paid by them otherwise, learned trial Court shall dispose of the application for grant of bail to the petitioners on the same day in accordance with law.
