Present Writ Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing letter dated 12.07.2023 (Annexure P-4) *qua* retaining right of the petitioners with regard to their respective plots; and further to quash letter dated 24.11.2022 (Annexure P-5).

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners would be satisfied, in case, their pending representation dated 08.11.2023 (Annexure P-7) is decided by respondent No.3, which has not been adverted to by the respondents till date.

3. On the other hand, on advance service of copy of petition, learned State counsel and learned counsel for respondents No.3 and 4 appear and oppose issuance of notice of motion. They submit that grievance of the petitioners will be looked into by respondent No.3 and it shall take decision either way, on pending representation dated 08.11.2023 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioners.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider pending representation dated 08.11.2023 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioners and pass an appropriate reasoned order, in accordance with law, at the earliest, preferably within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of copy/ production of this order.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
