**VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J (ORAL)**

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents/UOI contends that the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous inasmuch as the challenge raised in the present writ petition was to the order of de-attachment from Chandigarh Office whereupon the petitioner was required to join with Battalion at Tripura. She contends that the petitioner has thereafter been transferred and has been given permanent posting at Amritsar in 181 Battalion and he has already joined there.

Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, it seems that the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to espouse the grievance, if any, which still subsists.
