Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for short "BNSS, 2023", (erstwhile Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for short "Cr.P.C."), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.128 dated 19.09.2022, registered under Sections 387, 336, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 120-B & 201 IPC and Section 25(6) of the Arms Act, 1959 added lateron) at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.
