1. This is a petition seeking protection from the respondents and directions to the Director General of Police, Panchkula, Haryana, Inspector General of Police, South Range, Rewari and Superintendent of Police, Nuh, respectively, to conduct fair enquiry on the representations (Annexure P-1 to P-3), moved by the petitioner.

2. It has been contended that the petitioner has been illegally taken into custody and released by the police on three occasions and that till date, no FIR against him has been registered.

3. Notice of Motion.

4. Mr. Parveen Kumar Aggarwal, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned State counsel has submitted that the police has taken the cognizance on the representation of the petitioner and that the same has been marked to the Deputy Superintendent of Police by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Nuh. He has also stated that for the purpose of

enquiry, Deputy Superintendent of Police had issued notice to the petitioner for today itself. However, in this regard, learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner was not given any information by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, for any kind of enquiry/proceeding in the matter in question.

6. As agreed by learned counsel for both the parties, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Deputy Superintendent of Police, to whom, the representation has been marked by the Senior Superintendent of Police on 11.08.2025 to seek redressal of his grievance.

7. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the abovementioned direction, no cause of action survives for the maintainability of the present petition, hence the same is disposed of accordingly.
