Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for not complying the order dated 11.1.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Chief Administrator-respondent No.2 vide which direction was given to the respondent to release the arrear of pay fixation on promotion under the Person with Disabilities Quota with immediate effect under intimation to the office of the Chief Administrator-respondent No.2.

Ms. Dheerja, Advocate has put in appearance and filed Power of Attorney on behalf of respondent as well as Reply dated 16.9.2025 by way of affidavit of Shri Chander Singh, Secretary-cum-



Executive Officer, Market Committee, Ismailabad, Kurukshetra on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. The same are taken on record. Copy of the reply is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent contends that the present contempt petition is not maintainable as the order dated 11.1.2024 (Annexure P-1) is an internal communication between the members of the respondent Committee.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he may be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition with liberty to take recourse to the appropriate remedy as per law.

Heard.

In view of the facts noted above and the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present contempt petition is **dismissed as withdrawn** with the liberty aforesaid to the petitioner.

Rule stands discharged.
