Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent(s) for not complying the order dated 05.6.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-14417-2024 titled as "Ravichandran and others vs. UT Chandigarh and others" vide which while issuing notice of motion, the petition (CWP-14417-2024) was ordered to be heard alongwith the connected petition i.e. CWP-13683-2024 and interim order was granted in the same terms as in CWP-13683-2024, in which operation of the impugned letter/Memo dated 28.4.2024 (annexed as Annexure P-13 in that petition) qua the petitioners was ordered to be stayed.



Short reply dated 24.7.2025 by way of affidavit of Shri Dharminder Sharma, Superintending Engineer (B & R), Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record. Alongwith the said reply, copy of the Office Order No.33 dated 23.7.2025 passed by the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh in favour of the petitioner(s) has been annexed as Annexure R-1. Copy thereof is supplied to the counsel opposite.

Learned counsel for the parties also submit that a Contempt Petition bearing COCP-2498-2025, titled as “Jaya Gudi @ Jayapuri and others vs. Sh. Amit Kumar, Commissioner, IAS, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh and others”, in which similar issue was raised, has been decided by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 10.7.2025. Copy of the said order is handed over in the Court, which is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the aforesaid position, the present contempt petition may be disposed of in terms of COCP-2498-2025.

Heard.

In view of the request made by learned counsel for the petitioners as well as the fact that as per the short reply filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, the necessary compliance has been made by the respondent-authority while passing a Speaking Order dated 23.7.2025 (Annexure R-1), no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed of** accordingly.

Rule stands discharged.
