This application is for placing on record the original affidavits of respondents No.2 & 3 as Annexures P-5 & P-6 respectively.

2. Heard.

3. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the original affidavits of respondents No.2 & 3 as Annexures P-5 & P-6 are taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

**Main case**

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short-'BNSS') for quashing of FIR No.7 dated 17.10.2024, under Sections 509, 506 IPC and Section 66(C) of the Information Technology Act, 2000, registered at Cyber Crime Police Station Pathankot, District Pathankot and all the subsequent proceedings arising

therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 23.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) and the affidavits of respondents No.2 & 3 (Annexures P-5 & P-6) whereby the petitioners claim to have settled their differences with the private respondents.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amandeep Singh Samra, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

4. Mr. Jagjit Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 and has filed power of attorney in Court today, which is taken on record. He confirms the factum of the compromise having been effected between the parties and states that they have no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

5. In that view of the matter, even if this case is taken to its logical conclusion, it would only be an exercise in futility as the parties have already settled their differences. Therefore, no purpose would be served in wasting the time and resources of the State in pursuing this case to its pre-ordained end. It would, therefore, be better to give a quietus to the issue at this stage.

6. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and FIR No.7 dated 17.10.2024, under Sections 509, 506 IPC and Section 66(C) of the Information Technology Act, 2000, registered at Cyber Crime Police Station Pathankot, District Pathankot and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners shall stand quashed.
