As observed in the order dated 07.08.2025, despite service, the respondent did not make appearance on that date. Even today, he has not made appearance. As such, the respondent is proceeded against *ex parte*.

Counsel for the applicant heard.

The applicant-wife has filed the present application for seeking transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act i.e. HMA/276/2024, titled '*Simranjot Singh Vs. Amandeep Kaur*', filed by the respondent-husband, pending in the Family Court, Sangrur and she seeks transfer of the same to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

It is submitted by the counsel for the applicant that on account of the matrimonial dispute, the parties are residing separate. One daughter born from the wedlock of the parties, who is about 6 years old, is in the care and custody of the applicant. On query by this Court, it is submitted by the counsel that the applicant is not working. Also, it is submitted that the father

and brother of the applicant, are both 75% disabled. In this regard, certificates of disability have been placed on record, copies whereof are Annexures A-2 and A-3.

Considering the aforesaid mitigating circumstances, more particularly, considering fact about the respondent having not come forward to resist the application, the transfer application is allowed and the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act i.e. HMA/276/2024, titled '*Simranjot Singh Vs. Amandeep Kaur*', filed by the respondent-husband, stands transferred from the Family Court, Sangrur, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana. The requisite record of the aforesaid case be sent by the Family Court, Sangrur, to the District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana.

Learned District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, shall assign the said petition to the Family Court, Ludhiana. Even, the parties are directed to appear before the Family Court, Ludhiana, within a period of one month from today onwards.
