1. Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 of the BNS, 2023 (earlier Section 438 Cr.P.C.), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked in a criminal case arising out of First Information Report, as detailed hereunder:-

2. As per the allegations mentioned in the FIR, petitioner inflicted a sickle blow on the right side of the head of the injured, namely Dhanna Singh, which was subsequently opined to be a grievous injury.

Anticipatory bail petition of co-accused Tandeep Singh, who was attributed a sickle blow on the right hand of the injured, has already been dismissed, vide CRM-M-6479-2025, as informed by learned State counsel.

3. In view of these facts, petitioner's plea for anticipatory bail on the ground of parity with co-accused Jaspreet Singh @ Ashu and Avtar Singh, who have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court, vide orders dated 21.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) and 20.06.2025 (Annexure P-4) respectively, is not maintainable. Accordingly, present petition stands **dismissed**.
