1. Counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the earlier application given by respondent No.4 was filed by the police authorities after making proper inquiry. Despite this, the petitioner is even now being unnecessarily called to the police station on behest of respondents No.4 and 5, just to harass him. That the petitioner has already given his representation Annexure P-5 dated 24.02.2025 to the police authorities but no action has been taken by the police in this regard, till date. The petitioner will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation Annexure P-5 submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law, at the earliest, without any further delay.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that in case, any such representation given by the petitioner is pending, the same will be looked into and decided by the competent authority, as per law, in a given time frame.



4. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation dated 24.02.2025 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
