The instant application has been filed for extension of time to the petitioner to deposit 5% of the cheque amount within a period of 30 days, vide order dated 28.11.2024.

Notwithstanding the direction having been issued by this Court to the petitioner to deposit 5% of the cheque amount within a period of 30 days vide order dated 28.11.2024, the needful has not been done, even after the expiry of the period as prescribed.

The instant application has been filed for extension of time, however, there is no satisfactory explanation as to why the deposit could not be made till date. It has been put to the counsel as against the initial direction to deposit 5 % of the cheque amount, he would now be required to deposit 10% of the cheque amount within a period of one week from today. He undertakes to do the needful within the period of one week as above.

Interim order to continue, only subject to the deposit of the 10% of the cheque amount as ordered today.

The application is disposed of in above terms.
