1. Since the learned counsel for petitioner-judgment debtor submits that the judgment debtor is ready and willing to deposit the decretal amount. Therebys, this Court may order the judgment debtor to appear before the authority concerned on 03.03.2025, so that, the judgment debtor can proceed to deposit the decretal amount.

2. Shri Arjun Singh, Tehsildar, who is supervising the auction of the subject property, is present in the Court, thus thereupons, is led to state that the petitioner has made part deposit for satisfaction of the recovery certificate

therebys, subject property will not be subjected to sale through public auction at this stage. It is on the basis of the statement of the judgment debtor and submissions (supra), that this Court becomes further led to both stay the instant auction proceedings and to also quash the impugned public auction.

3. Therefore, nothing survives in the writ petition, and is disposed of accordingly.

4. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
