



also been recorded, wherein it has been mentioned that as per the compromise, he (Sahil Goyal) has no objection to quash the FIR. Subsequent to the recording of the said statement, NOC dated 17.05.2025 has also been issued by the bank authorities.

3. Today, learned counsel for respondent No.2-Bank also endorses the factum of compromise and he has no objection, if the FIR is quashed.

4. In view of the fact that financial dispute has been resolved between the parties by way of compromise, their respective statements have been recorded before the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Baghapurana, as also the fact that bank has issued the NOC, continuation of the present FIR is nothing, but sheer abuse of process of law.

5. The present petition is allowed and the FIR No.226 dated 16.11.2024, registered under Section 420, 406, 120-B IPC at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga and all proceedings subsequent thereto is hereby quashed qua petitioners.
