1. Instant second petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.17 dated 02.03.2024, registered under Sections 341, 328, 323, 34 IPC (Section 376 IPC added later on) at Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Varinder Kumar, submits that since the petitioner is absconding, therefore, proclamation proceedings are going on against him and arrest warrants have been issued for 11.04.2025. He further submits that in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Srikant Upadhyay and others v. State of Bihar and another, 2024 AIR Supreme Court 1600*, instant petition is not maintainable.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
