The present writ petition has been filed seeking directions to the respondents to regularize the service of the petitioner in terms of policy/notification dated 29.07.2011 (Annexure P-2) and a further prayer to direct the respondents to grant salary to the petitioner in regular pay scale with effect from the aforesaid policy with all consequential benefits including seniority and arrears alongwith interest @ 12% per annum.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has served a Legal Notice dated 17.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.3-the Treasury Officer, Hisar is directed to

consider and decide the Legal Notice dated 17.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) served by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rahul Dev, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. He, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the Legal Notice dated 17.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of four months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that if upon considering the said representation, in case any monetary benefit is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in her favour within a further period of two months.
