Learned counsel for the appellant submits that since the final decree has been passed vide judgment and decree dated 14.01.2025, the appellant intends to challenge the same instead of pursuing the present appeal.

2. Learned counsel further submits that since the final decree was passed on 14.01.2025, the appellant may face the hurdle of limitation. He prays that in the appeal to be preferred by him against the final judgment and decree, a lenient view as regards the limitation be taken.

3. Keeping in view the statement given by learned counsel for the appellant, the present appeal is dismissed as having been withdrawn. The appellant may, if so advised, prefer an appeal against the final judgment and decree dated 14.01.2025.

4. Since the appellant had been pursuing the present appeal, this Court is sanguine that the Court concerned shall deal with the application for condonation of delay, if so filed, sympathetically.
