**HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)**

1. Learned State counsel representing the respondents on instructions from Smt. Sneha Prabha, Assistant, WCD, Haryana and Smt. Arti Singh, ADA, WCD, Haryana submits that order dated 16.12.2024 (Annexure P-7) was passed in terms of previous speaking order dated 15.10.2024 which becomes redundant in terms of the order passed by the Writ Court followed by speaking order dated 23.01.2025 passed by the Director, Women & Child Development Department, Haryana, Panchkula.

2. It has also been pointed out by learned State counsel that necessary benefits payable to the petitioner shall be released within 04 weeks from today.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

5. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
