1. Prayer in the present Civil Revision Petition, filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, is for issuing directions to the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Jagadhri (First Appellate Court), to decide the petitioner's application dated 12.10.2023, filed under Order XLI Rule 5 of the CPC (Annexure P-5), for staying the operation of the judgment and decree dated 15.09.2023 (Annexure P-3) in Civil Appeal No. CA-334/2023 (Annexure P-4) at the earliest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the next date fixed before the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Jagadhri, is 01.10.2025. In view thereof, directions are sought to the said Court to decide the application filed under Order XLI Rule 5 of the CPC (Annexure P-5) by hearing the arguments on the said date itself. A copy of the order dated 22.09.2025, passed by the learned Additional District Judge,

Jagadhri, showing the next date as 01.10.2025, has been supplied by learned counsel for the petitioner in Court today. The same is taken on record.
