JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to consider him for compassionate appointment in terms of The Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Government Employee Rules, 2003 or Haryana Civil Services (Compassionate Financial Assistance or Appointment) Rules, 2019.

2. Petitioner's father was working with respondent who passed away in harness on 26.02.2002. The petitioner is claiming that his brother applied for job on compassionate ground in 2002. The said application was never rejected. At present his brother is more than 50 years old and he has no objection if petitioner is considered for the job.



3. Mr. Monit Pal Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner's family was neither extended *ex-gratia* compensation nor benefit of compassionate appointment.

4. On being confronted with judgment of Supreme Court in ***Umesh Kumar Nagpal vs. State of Haryana, (1994) 4 SCC 138***, Mr. Monit submits that respondents may be directed to consider his case for *ex- gratia* financial assistance.

5. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who on advance notice is present in Court, submits that case of petitioner for financial assistance would be considered as per applicable Rules and Regulations, if not granted on the earlier occasion.

6. Mr. Monit agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.

7. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.

8. Needful shall be done within three months from today.
