1. The indolent and lackadaisical approach of respondents, propelled the present petitioner file the instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a *mandamus* for taking a final decision on the representation dated 26.12.2024 (Annexure P-3) in view of the guidelines laid down by this Court in CWP-22904-2016, vide judgement dated 14.11.2023.

2. Considering the aforesaid prayer, as made by learned counsel for the petitioner, being innocuous and *bona fide*, this Court, without issuing notice to the respondents, directs respondent no.2 and 3 to take cognizance of representation (*supra*), as moved by the petitioner, and thereupon, take a final decision, by passing a speaking order, within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this Court.
