The present application has been moved with a prayer to implead Rahila, Ahmer, Shanhma and Shan Mohammad as respondents No.7 to 10.

Notice of the application.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Kumar Banku, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and Rahila, Ahmer, Shanhma and Shan Mohammad is ordered to be impleaded as respondents No. 7 to 10 in the memo of parties. The amended memo of parties is taken on record.

Main case

1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 13.06.2025 (Annexure P-3) to the Superintendent of Police, Palwal-respondent No.2 and he shall be satisfied in case respondent-No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Palwal -respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 13.06.2025(Annexure P-3) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two weeks from today.

4. Before taking any action in the matter, respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Palwal shall hear the petitioners as well as respondentsNo.4 and 5.
