VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J (ORAL)

CWP No.12091 of 2016 was disposed of on 08.05.2019 and the following directions were passed:-

***“4. In view of the above factual position, the present writ petition is allowed with a direction to the respondents to revise the pay scale of the petitioner w.e.f. 26.06.1997 i.e. date of his promotion, in the pay scale of Rs.3000-4500/-+300 for the post of 'Assistant Registrar'. The respondents shall re-calculate his pay, arrears and retiral benefits and give him all consequential benefits thereof along with interest @ 8% per annum.***

***5. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”***

2. Learned counsel representing the respondent refers to the reply submitted by way of affidavit of Dr. Navjot Kaur, Registrar Punjabi University, Patiala, as per which the entire dues stand paid. Calculations have also been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed. However, if the petitioner finds that some amount still remains to be paid in terms of the directions issued in CWP No.12091 of 2016, he would be at liberty to move an application for revival of the instant contempt petition.

The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of.
