Learned counsel for respondent Municipal Corporation submits that in terms of speaking order dated 24.01.2025, the procedure laid down under Section 269 of the Punjab Municipal Corporation Act, 1956 shall be followed, if applicable and the necessary exercise shall be carried out within 02 weeks from today.

2. In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

3. Dismissed as not pressed

4. Rule discharged.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.

6. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum

of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
