Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023, is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.37 dated 25.04.2024, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 (Sections 460, 326, 325 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Jalalabad, District Fazilka.

2. Brief facts of the case are that on 10.3.2024, the petitioner and the co-accused who were armed with weapons formed unlawful assembly and caused injuries to the complainant and his wife Kiranpreet Kaur while entering in their house at night time. Manjeet Singh has exhorted that the complainant party be not spared. He was armed with iron pipe fitted with iron fly wheel and gave blow directly on the head of the complainant.

Gurmeet Singh @ Rimpay armed with iron pipe, Amarjeet Singh and Binder Kaur @ Akko armed with dangs, Harnek Singh armed with “Kirch”, Bunty armed with “Kirch”, Gurpreet Singh @ Gori armed with dang, Gurmail Singh entered their house and Gurmeet Singh @ Rimpay and Harnek Singh caused injuries to the complainant. Complainant raised hue and cry and when her wife Kiranpreet Kaur came to rescue him, then Rimpay, Binder Kaur @ Akko and Seema Rani also caused injuries to her. Afterward, the injured were admitted at Civil Hospital. Hence the present FIR was registered.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has inter alia contended that the petitioner was only alleged to be armed with stick and no grievous injuries has been attributed to her. There is no attribution that she has caused any injury on the person of complainant-Sandeep Singh. He has also submitted that there is considerable delay in the registration of the present FIR. He has further submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the investigation.

4. Learned State counsel filed status report by way of affidavit of Jatinder Singh Gill, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Jalalabad, District Fazilka and per contra contended that the petitioner along with co-accused by forming unlawful assembly inflicted grievous injuries upon the complainant. So, she is not entitled for concession of anticipatory bail.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the record.

6. As per the allegations, the petitioner was armed with a stick and she gave a stick blow on the back of the wife of the complainant-Kiranpreet Kaur. The grievous injuries have been attributed to the co-accused and not to the petitioner. Her custodial interrogation is not required for any purpose.

7. Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. In the event of arrest, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on furnishing bail/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions, as provided under Section 482(2) of BNSS. It will be open for the Investigating Officer to call the petitioner to join investigation, if so required, by issuing a written notice in this regard. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

8. However, nothing observed herein above shall be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case. The observations recorded above are only for the purpose of deciding the present bail petition.
