KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner, who is a decree holder, filed an execution application in the year 2019 and which is still pending adjudication, despite the judgment debtor caused appearance, which propelled him to file the instant petition for issuance of a mandamus upon the learned Civil Judge concerned to decide his execution application in a time bound manner.

2. What reflects from the perusal of the instant petition is that the petitioner had earlier filed a civil suit for possession by way of specific performance of agreement for sale-deed dated 25.10.2006 and the suit was allowed vide judgment and decree dated 29.8.2019

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the judgment and decree (supra), has attained finality and despite that the execution application, which was filed in the year 2019 has not been decided.

4. Considering the above facts and circumstances, this Court deems apt to **dispose** of the instant petition with a mandamus upon the Executing Court concerned to make all endeavour to decide the execution bearing No.91/2019 within 6 months from today.

5. **Ordered** accordingly.
