By way of this civil writ petition, prayer was made to issue writ of mandamus or any appropriate writ to direct the respondents to release pension and other pensionary benefits of Ravinder Kumar, deceased husband of petitioner No.1 and father of petitioner No.2 along with consequential benefits to the petitioners.

Today, it is conceded that one of the respondent of this petition, namely, Geeta Rani along with two others have already filed a petition bearing SUCC/38/2023 for issuance of succession certificate in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), which is also referred in the order dated 15.10.2024 of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Jagadhri during the proceedings of Civil Suit No.2309 of 2018, titled "**Geeta v. XEN etc.**".
