Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.0207 dated 13.09.2021, under Sections 336, 323, 506, 509, 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860; Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at



Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise by way of an affidavit dated 10.01.2023 (P-2).

(2) On 19.11.2024, the Coordinate Bench passed the following order:-

“CRM-45230-2024

1. *For the good and valid reasons, as recorded in the application for placing on record the compromise deed as Annexure P-4, therefore, the application is allowed.*

CRM-M-3054-2024

2. *Mr. Sarvesh Kumar Gupta, Advocate, records his appearance on behalf of the respondent No.2, under a memorandum of appearance instituted before this Court today, and, as prayed for, he is permitted to file a validly executed Vakalatnama in his favour by the respondent concerned, on or before the subsequent date of hearing.*

3. *The learned counsel for the petitioner seeks one more opportunity to implead victim Jagpreet Singh in the array of respondents in the instant petition.*

4. *Request allowed.*

5. *List on 22.01.2025.”*

(3) Despite sufficient time, needful has not been done in the matter.

(4) In view of the above, it appears that petitioners are not interested in pursuing the petition.

(5) Disposed off accordingly.



(6) Needless to say that in case an occasion so arises, petitioners would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
