1. Through the instant petition, as filed under 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) 2023, the petitioner has sought issuance of directions upon the respondents No. 2 to 3, not to humiliate and harass him by calling him to their office in odd hours without their being any justified reason.

2. The counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a senior citizen and resident of Zirakpur. Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 are calling him in their office at Kapurthala only on the ground that he was a witness to the agreement to sell dated 21.10.2023 (Annexure P-2). He further contends that the petitioner filed a representation dated 28.04.2025 (Annexure P-4) through registered post to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala and till date, the said representation has not been looked into.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondent(s) only.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harkanwar Jeet Singh, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondent(s).



5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the representation dated 28.04.2025, which has been placed on record (as Annexure P-4), be looked into.
6. Learned State counsel does not object to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and contends that the representation dated 28.04.2025 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner would be decided within a period of four weeks by passing a speaking order.
7. In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, to decide the above referred to representation (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner, within a period of four weeks from today by passing a speaking order.
8. Disposed of accordingly.
