1. Learned counsel for the appellants submits that by the impugned judgment dated 05.07.2024 passed by the learned Single Judge of this Court in CWP-11303-2022 a direction has been given to the appellants to acquire the balance land of the respondent as there is no *rasta* available with the respondent to reach his unacquired land keeping in view the portion of the land already acquired by the appellants.

2. Learned counsel for the appellants submits that all the efforts are being made to provide *rasta* to the respondent to reach to his unacquired land and a proposal for the same will be finalized in consultation with the Ministry concerned within a period of 08 weeks and in case, it is found that it is not feasible to provide *rasta* to the respondent to reach to his unacquired land, the judgment dated 05.07.2024 passed by the learned Single Judge of this Court will be complied with within a further period of two months.

3. Learned Senior counsel appearing for the respondent submits that keeping in view the undertaking given by the learned counsel for the appellants hereinbefore, he does not oppose the said proposal of the learned counsel appearing for the appellants.

4. Keeping in view the above, present appeal is disposed of with the observation that as undertaken by the appellants, the appellants in consultation with the Ministry concerned will decide whether a *rasta* is to be provided to the respondent to reach to his unacquired land within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order failing which, impugned judgment dated 05.07.2024 passed by the learned Single Judge of
