Dr. (Mr.) D.S. Lamba, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and prays for some time to complete his instructions and file reply, if so advised. At this stage, Mr. Sanjay Khan, Advocate enters appearance and files memorandum of appearance on behalf of the complainant today in the Court and the same is taken on record. He contends that they are interested in recovery of money, however, he prays for some time to verify as to whether cheque No.000901 dated 06.02.2024 has been received by the complainant or not.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that co-accused have already been granted bail vide order dated 27.12.2024 passed by this Court in CRM-M-65530-2024.

Adjourned to 27.01.2025.

Reply, if any, be filed on or before the adjourned date with copy in advance to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Agency. In the event of the petitioner joining investigation, he shall be admitted to interim bail by the arresting officer/investigating officer on his furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/investigating officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) of 2023.

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-65530-2024.'

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Nishant, at the very outset informs the Court that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the statement of learned State counsel, order dated 02.01.2025 is hereby made absolute. The petitioners shall abide by the terms and conditions envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS (earlier Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.).

The petition stands disposed of.
