1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is for setting aside the order dated 01.09.2023 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar in FIR bearing No.101 dated 30.05.2018 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of IPC, 12 of Passports Act, 1967, 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals Regulation Act, 2014 at Police Station Division No.6, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that in compliance of the order passed by this Court on 22.04.2025 in case bearing CRM-M No.9515 of 2025, the jurisdictional police authorities are in process of filing a supplementary challan, after segregating the trial qua the different accused.
