By way of the present petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, prayer is made by the petitioner is for issuing appropriate directions to learned Civil Judge (Junior Division) Abohar for earlier and expeditious disposal of the application (Annexure P-7), whereby prayer was made for passing the final decree, bearing No.CM No.6 of 2021.
