1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of DDR No.43 dated 27.02.2019 under Sections 324/323/148/149/325 of IPC (Annexure P-2) in FIR No.26 dated 27.02.2019 under Sections 324/323/148/149 of IPC (Section 325 of IPC added later on) (Annexure P-1) registered at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (charges framed under Sections 148/323/325/149 of IPC) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 20.01.2025 (Annexure P-3).

2. The following order was passed on 26.03.2025 :-

*“This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of DDR No.43 dated 27.02.2019 under Sections 324/323/148/149/325 of IPC (Annexure P-2) in FIR No.26 dated 27.02.2019 under Sections 324/323/148/149 of IPC (Section 325 of IPC added lateron) (Annexure P-1) registered at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (charges framed under Sections 148/323/325/149 of IPC) along with all subsequent*



*proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 20.01.2025 (Annexure P-3).*

*Notice of motion for 28.04.2025.*

*At this stage, on the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State. Copy of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of day. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to secure the presence of respondents No.2 & 3 before the learned trial Court at the time of recording the statement.*

*In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate within two weeks from today or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, to get their statements recorded regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed.*

*A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate through fax for compliance.”*

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 46***, and ***Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63*** and Full Bench of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052***, this petition is allowed and DDR No.43 dated 27.02.2019 under Sections 324/323/148/149/325 of IPC (Annexure P-2) in FIR No.26 dated 27.02.2019 under Sections 324/323/148/149 of IPC (Section 325 of IPC added later on)



(Annexure P-1) registered at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (charges framed under Sections 148/323/325/149 of IPC) and all consequential proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioners.
