By way of the present writ petition, the petitioners have sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to allot a plot under the "Oustee Category", as per Policy dated 17.04.1974 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already made a representation dated 17.02.2024 (Annexure P-10) to the competent authority-respondent No.4 for redressal of their grievances, but no action has been taken thereon till date. He further submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, if the respondent

authorities are directed to deal with their concerns/grievances and pass appropriate order on the said representation.

3. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. T.P.S. Walia, AAG, Punjab, is present in Court and submits that the said representation shall be considered and decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 (competent authority), to look into the pending representation dated 17.02.2024 (Annexure P-10) of the petitioners and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law after giving an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioners, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
