In compliance of the order dated 04.03.2025, learned counsel for the respondent relies upon an affidavit dated 28.03.2025 filed by the Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar with respect to preparation of the following schedule:-

*“.....Annexure R/2, wherein the following schedule has been prepared:-*

- i) Public notice for inviting claims and objections has already been done.*
- ii) Four months for the preparation of draft for the missing record from dated 03.03.2025 to 02.07.2025.*
- iii) One month time for filing claims and objections against the draft before the Naib Tehsildar cum Assistant Collector IInd Grade, Nakodar from 03.07.2025 to 02.08.2025.*
- iv) One month for filing appeal before the Sub Divisional Magistrate cum Assistant Collector Ist Grade Nakodar from 03.08.2025 to 02.09.2025.*
- v) Three months for the preparation of final missing record from 03.09.2025 to 02.12.2025.”*

Learned counsel for the respondent on specific instructions from the deponent of the aforesaid affidavit submits that the aforementioned schedule shall be strictly adhered to regarding consolidation and preparation of revenue record.

In view thereof, no cause survives in the aforesaid petition and the same is thus, disposed of.

Rule discharged.

However, it is made clear that in case, the respondent fails to abide by the aforesaid undertaking, 1/3<sup>rd</sup> salary of respondent shall remain attached till the compliance is made.
