The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.4 to decide representation dated 04.03.2024 (Annexure P-4) and to take action against respondent No.7 (Rajwati, Sarpanch) as she has filed fake education certificate with the nomination form.
