1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for setting aside the impugned orders dated 19.07.1995, 29.08.1995 and 06.05.1995 (Annexures P-1, P-2 and P-3) passed by respondents No.3, 2 and 1, respectively.

2. A perusal of order sheets would reveal that on 08.08.2024, the following order was passed:

*“As per office report, there is no information regarding Mr. D.N. Tanwar, Advocate, counsel for the petitioner, in the Bar Directory nor he was available in the Bar Room.*
