Short reply by way of an affidavit of Mr. Kamal Kishor Yadav, Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of School Education, Chandigarh has been filed on behalf of respondent No.1, the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for respondents on instructions from Mr. Kamal Kishore Yadav, Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of School Education informs that the re-casted merit list shall be implemented and appointment letters shall be issued in favour of the meritorious candidates within a period of 4 weeks.

In view of the aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

Rule discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned Officer would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
