Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for not complying the order dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRWP-10238-2024 titled as “Vipan Kumar and others vs. State of Punjab and others” vide which the petition was disposed of with a direction to the respondent herein to consider the representation dated 25.6.2024 (Annexure P-5 in the said CRWP) and decide the same b passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly, as per law, within a period of two weeks from 23.10.2024.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondent that the order dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) of which the contempt is alleged, has already been complied with and a Speaking Order dated



04.12.2024 has already been passed by the competent authority; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid Speaking Order dated 04.12.2024 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the said fact and prays that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition, however, with liberty to challenge the said Speaking Order dated 04.12.2024, if so advised, as per law.

Ordered accordingly.

Rule stands discharged.
