1. Present contempt petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act 1971 for violating the orders dated 11.07.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

2. Learned State counsel has submitted that in pursuance of the above-said order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the necessary order has been passed in favour of the petitioners and a copy of the same has been handed over to the Court and is taken on record and has been marked as "Mark A (Colly.)". A copy of the said order has also been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the above-said aspect satisfies the petitioners but the respondent authorities be directed to release the amount found due to the petitioners in a time bound manner.

4. Learned State counsel has submitted that the amount found due to the petitioners would be released to them within a period of four weeks from today.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the above, the present contempt petition be disposed of, but liberty be granted to the petitioners to revive the present petition in case the respondent authorities back-track from the above-said statement.

6. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present contempt petition is disposed of. The respondent would be bound by the statement made before this Court. Liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the present contempt petition in case the respondent back-track from the said statement.
