These petitions have been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.124 dated 08.09.2024 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

This Court, vide order dated 12.11.2024 passed in CRM-M-56356-2024 and order dated 27.11.2024 passed in CRM-M-59308-2024, had directed the petitioners to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer and

join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the SHO/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 482(2) of the BNSS (erstwhile Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders dated 12.11.2024 and 27.11.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined and cooperated with the investigation.

Learned State Counsel on instructions states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State Counsel, the petitions are allowed and the interim orders dated 12.11.2024 and 27.11.2024 are **made absolute**.

The petitioners will, however, continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and will also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
