The present revision petition is directed against the order dated 24.09.2025 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Panchkula, vide which the evidence of the petitioner-wife was closed by order.

2. The respondent-husband filed a petition under Section 13(1) (i-a) and (i-b) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short the "HMA") for a decree of divorce on the ground of cruelty and desertion before the Court of learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Panchkula. For, the petitioner-wife could not lead and conclude her evidence on time, the same was closed by order on 24.09.2025 (Annexure P-4), leading to filing of the present revision petition.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only one effective opportunity would be required by the petitioner to lead and conclude her evidence. He submits that the petitioner had exercised due diligence but despite the same, the evidence could not be concluded in time. Learned counsel undertakes that the petitioner would not delay the proceedings and would lead and conclude the evidence in one effective opportunity.
