1. The present contempt petition has been filed by the petitioner under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Court Act and under Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating the contempt proceedings against respondents for violating the order dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Division Bench of this court.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the impugned order has been complied with but has submitted that some amount on account of interest would also be payable to the petitioner. However, it is submitted that the present petition be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate proceedings for the prayer of interest, which as per the petitioner is due to it.

3. In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.



4. Needless to say that in case any such proceeding is instituted, it would be open to both the parties to raise all the pleas which are available to them.
