MANDEEP PANNU J.

1. The petitioner has filed the present Civil Revision Petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a direction to the Trial Court/Family Court, Kurukshetra to decide Case No. HMA-596-2023 titled *Paramjeet Vs. Krishan Kumar* in a time-bound manner.
2. The respondent was proceeded ex-parte before the Family Court, due to non-appearance despite service of summons. Considering the circumstances, this Court is of the view that notice to the respondent in the present revision petition is not required.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite filing the petition for divorce under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act on 17.08.2023, and after examination of witnesses and passing of orders for ex-parte arguments on multiple dates, the Family Court is repeatedly adjourning the matter without hearing the ex-parte arguments, thereby causing undue delay and prejudice to the

petitioner. He further submits that the pendency of the divorce petition is adversely affecting prospects of remarriage of the petitioner and her right to live a happy life.

4. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the facts and circumstances of the case in hand, this Court is of the opinion that the delay caused by the Family Court in deciding the matter on merits is unsatisfactory and against the interest of justice. The petitioner is entitled to expeditious disposal of matrimonial dispute, especially when the respondent has not contested the proceedings.

5. In exercise of the powers vested under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, this Court requests the Principal Judge, Family Court, Kurukshetra, to decide Case No. HMA-596-2023, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. The Civil Revision Petition is accordingly allowed.

7. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
