1. Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.308 dated 02.10.2014 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar Mohali, challan dated 07.08.2019 and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. CRM-M-46691 of 2024 was filed by the petitioner on 16.09.2024 with identical prayer. That petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 20.09.2024 and a direction was given to the trial Court to expedite the trial and conclude the same within a period of 6 months from the date of receipt/production of certified copy of the order.

3. On the last date of hearing, report of learned trial Court was sought regarding the conclusion of trial. The report duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge concerned has been received. Learned

JMIC, Dera Bassi has reported that she joined at Dera Bassi on 01.05.2025 whereafter, she proceeded on Child Care Leave and the case was put up before her for the first time on 05.06.2025. When she learnt that it was time bound by this Court and had to be disposed of by 06.05.2025, the case was tried expeditiously and disposed of on 23.09.2025.

4. Since the criminal case has already been determined, no further action in the matter is called for. The petition stands disposed of.
