On the asking of court, Mr.Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.A.G.,  
Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 2.3.2016 passed by  
the writ court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to take into consideration the recommendation dated 6.2.2014 (Annexure P/2) made by respondent No.2 and the legal notice dated 17.12.2015 (Annexure P/10) and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case any adverse order is to be passed then a reasoned order be passed by the said respondent and be conveyed to the petitioner.

The present writ petition is disposed off with the aforesaid directions.”

Learned State counsel submits that in case no appeal is pending against the aforesaid order, it shall be implemented forthwith in any case not later than one month.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, no further direction is necessary.

Disposed of.

It is, however, made clear that in case fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner, this court shall consider imposition of exemplary costs which shall be deducted from the salary of the officials responsible for delay/non compliance.
