1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim of the petitioner for the grant of benefit of regularization of her services is covered by the decision of the Coordinate Bench of this Court in **CWP-1824-2014 titled as Surjit Kaur vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 16.01.2015,** which judgment has already attained finality up to the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India hence, the respondents be directed to decide the claim of the petitioner for regularization of her services in terms of the said order by passing appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioner for regularization of her services will be decided by the respondents keeping in view the judgment in **Surjit Kaur (supra)** by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of copy of this order. In case, it is found feasible to accept the

claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed which order will be conveyed to the petitioner for her information and necessary action.
