1. Prayer in the present second petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No. 45 dated 20.03.2025, registered under Sections 127(2), 304 of BNS, 2023 and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.
2. This is the second petition filed for grant of anticipatory bail. Earlier, the petitioner had approached this Court by way of filing CRM-M-19634-2025, praying for the same relief, however, on hearing the matter at length, when the Court was not inclined to grant concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner prayed for withdrawal of the said petition, with liberty to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of one week and file an application for grant of bail, which was directed to be decided expeditiously vide order dated 09.04.2025.
3. From the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any change of circumstance. Thus, neither there is any merit for the maintainability of the present successive petition nor there is any ground on merit of this petition. Hence, the same is hereby dismissed.
